

Funding set to transform Milngavie football pitch

Footballers in Milngavie will have an upgraded pitch to show off their fancy footwork this season thanks to a £30,500 investment.

The Council, on behalf of EDLC Trust, have appointed contractors Allstone Glasgow Ltd to carry out drainage improvement works on the pitch at Oakburn Park.

The work, which should reduce waterlogging on the pitch, was identified as one of the Milngavie Open Space priority projects in the Council's Open Space Strategy.

Councillor Billy Hendry, Convener of the Council's Place, Neighbourhood & Corporate Assets Committee, said, "I'm delighted that this work is now underway. Poor drainage can cause

inconvenience to those who use the pitch and has resulted in a reduction of bookings in the past.

"The improvements will allow for more people to play on the pitch for longer and is all part of our work towards enhanced recreational facilities within Oakhurn Park"

Sandy Marshall, Chair of EDLC Trust, said, "This work should ensure that during the next season fewer matches will be lost to the weather.

"Having a good quality pitch to play on will make it a great place for teams to play on and for visitors to enjoy."

It is anticipated that the work should take between four and six weeks to complete and the pitch should be available for play in late summer.

New school all set for pupils

THE new £10 million primary school in Bearsden was handed over to the council by construction company Morgan Sindall in good time before the first pupils start back after the holidays.

The school, designed for 450 pupils, has enabled the co-location of two former schools which were in need of modernisation.

It has been built on the site of what was St Andrew's Primary, replacing it, and allowing pupils from the former St Joseph's Primary, in nearby Milngavie, to be taught on the same site.

Children, staff and parents were given a chance to name the new school, opting for St Nicholas' Primary. Construction company Morgan Sindall invited pupils on tours to see how the new school was shaping up.

Stuart Parker, Morgan Sindall's managing director for Scotland, said:

"We're incredibly pleased to complete this important project
for the council and it's particularly gratifying to hand it

over early. The other schools we've built have been universally well-received. I'm confident St Nicholas' will be no different."

Council Joint Leader, Vaughan Moody, said: "The children coming to St Nicholas' in August will be educated in a building with all modern facilities. Our thanks to Morgan Sindall for delivering the school to the council in good time."

Town enjoys new facilities

Milngavie has benefitted from the launch of a new community facility opened earlier this summer, which includes public toilets, a meeting space, and a new information point for locals and visitors.

The Waypoint at Milngavie Youth Centre was officially launched on Thursday, 28 June and comes following a row over a lack of public facilities in Milngavie, the last town before the West Highland Way.

East Dunbartonshire Council previously allocated $\pounds60,000$ in capital funding and $\pounds12,000$ in revenue funding for a community management and empowerment programme at the centre.

Milngavie Youth Centre chairman Gordon McCorkindale said: "This is a wonderful day for the Youth Centre and Milngavie.

"It has taken longer than we anticipated – due to a number of logistical challenges – but the trustees are delighted that The Waypoint is now open.

"We are grateful for the support of the council and

a number of organisations for their assistance."

The site at Mugdock Road is owned by the council but leased to the youth centre on a long-term basis.

Local building in the running for top award

A Bearsden building has made the shortlist for a prestigious UK-wide honour.

The rejuvenated Kilmardinny House is in the running for Civic Building of the Year by SPACES (Society for Public Architecture, Construction, Engineering and Surveying). It is one of only 19 projects chosen from across the UK.

The Grade A-listed building reopened last year after a £2.73m programme of works.

SPACES' judges will visit Kilmardinny and the other projects in the coming months, with the winner announced on 11 October.

Scheme that encourages active travel bags award

A prestigious award was bagged by a local scheme that was developed to promote active travel and public transport throughout the area.

The Scottish Transport Award for Excellence in Walking & Public Realm was won by the Milngavie Station Travel Hub recently.

To achieve their aim the East Dunbartonshire Council project includes many enhancements to ease and encourage residents to reduce their carbon footprint.

Major public realm improvements, bus priority measures, better pedestrian access, increased parking, high-quality new surfacing, enhanced street furniture and facilities, and improved planting and landscaping are some of the steps being taken to improve accessibility. It's also hoped they will appeal to a greater audience.

The new hub makes it easier to connect journeys whether you are travelling by train, bike, bus or car.

It also creates a welcoming gateway to the town centre - encouraging footfall and a greater number of visitors.

Funding was secured by the Council from Transport Scotland's Bus Investment Fund and Strathclyde Partnership for Transport.

Milngavie Station Travel Hub was also shortlisted for Integrated Transport Project of the Year at the Scottish Transport Awards.

Sustainable travel hubs have also been set up in the Kessington and Hillfoot areas of Bearsden.

Milngavie Station is the busiest station in East Dunbartonshire and 31st busiest in Scotland with 966.286 users in 2016/17.


