## Life-saving training to be extended to more schools

East Dunbartonshire Council are continuing their efforts to ensure all secondary school pupils throughout the area receive a form of CPR training.

At a meeting of the council's education committee recently. councillor Denis Johnston put forward a motion supporting this training, which is already provided in several local schools.

Councillor Johnston said: "Only one in 12 people survive an out of hospital cardiac arrest compared to one in ten in Denmark. In Seattle, it is as high as 1 in four.

"We need to improve these statistics any way we can."

In unanimously voting for the



motion, councillors noted the important work achieved bv organisations such as the British Heart Foundation, which provides free CPR training.

The Evening Times has also campaigned to ensure every Scottish pupil leaves school with the training.

Research carried out by the British Heart Foundation and international organisations has shown that training pupils in CPR techniques could potentially triple the survival rate for these emergencies.

Council officers are reviewing the current delivery of CPR training in East Dunbartonshire schools and will recommend how to extend this across all secondary schools, while working in liaison with the British Heart Foundation.

# New cycle initiative makes a splash...

The charity has been working in partnership with the nation's only semiprofessional women's sports team since 2017 to promote child safety.

The programme aims to help children, in an age-appropriate way, to understand abuse in all its forms and recognise the signs that it is happening, learn how to protect themselves from abuse and recognise how to get help – including from the NSPCC's Childline service.

NSPCC research shows that on average at least two children in every primary school classroom will have suffered some form of abuse or neglect.

Interactive discussions and videos used during the assemblies gave the children help and tips on how to discuss and explore what constitutes harmful behaviour.

Ella said: "The message is very powerful and I am delighted the Strathclyde Sirens are on board to promote this vital message."

## Kids in Milngavie welcome play park

#### Children in Milngavie are swinging with joy thanks to the fantastic new play park right in the heart of the community.

Situated in Milngavie precinct, the new play area replaces an existing facility which had been installed in 2004 and brings a new lease of life to the town centre.

The new facility, which opened in January, incorporates new safety surfacing with colourful graphics, new bowtop fencing and self-closing gates.

Councillor Susan Murray, Vice Convener of the Place, Neighbourhood & Corporate Assets Committee, was joined by children from Milngavie Nursery at the official opening of the play area, which was built thanks to a £40,000 investment from the Council.

Councillor Murray said: "Milngavie Precinct is amongst the smaller of the Council's play areas but usually one of the busiest.

"Within 10 minutes of opening it was full and many young children were enjoying the new facility, which was fantastic to see. Feedback from these users has been hugely positive and we are delighted to see it being so well-used."



The new facility features a castle multi-play unit which can accommodate toddlers as well as older children up to eight years of age. Other features include play items such as talking tubes, "springies", a tea cup spinner, play binoculars and a saddle swing.

In addition, new seating has also been installed for parents and carers. There is also a small mural on the inside wall which shows the route of the West Highland Way which starts only a stone's throw away.
