Local park attracts film fans

Two of Scotland's top bloggers battled it out to visit as many film and real-life locations associated with Robert the Bruce in under 36 hours, to coincide with the release of Outlaw King on Netflix.

In November, Neil Robertson and David Weinczok, who form part of social media collective, Scotlanders, took on the challenge set by Visit Scotland. Between 10 and 11 November, they sought to connect social media users with the true story of the King of Scots, visiting iconic locations including Mugdock Country Park.

Film fans were able to take a virtual tour of the filming locations by tracking Neil's movements using the hashtag #ReelOutlawKing, while history buffs explored the real historical

sites linked to the Bruce through David and the hashtag #RealOutlawKing, on both Twitter and Instagram.

During the challenge, the bloggers came face-to-face at The Battle of Bannockburn at 1.14pm (1314 – in reference to the year that the Battle of Bannockburn took place), before finally coming together again on Sunday at Dunfermline Abbey, home to the Abbey Church which contains the resting place of the real Robert the Bruce.

Other locations the Scotlanders will visit included Mugdock Country Park, Glasgow Cathedral, Arbroath Abbey, Scone Palace and Loudoun Hill.

Outlaw King was shot entirely in Scotland (according to the borders of 1320) and is said to be the largest production, budget-wise, to be made in the country to date.

Dozens of locations were used in the production, including Craigmillar Castle, Blackness Castle, Linlithgow Palace, Glen Coe, Dunfermline Abbey, the University of Glasgow and the Isle of Skye.

Starring Chris Pine as the Bruce and Aaron Taylor-Johnson as James Douglas and directed by David MacKenzie, Outlaw King tells the story of Robert the Bruce, from defeated nobleman in 1304 to victorious King of Scots at the Battle of Loudoun Hill in 1307.

With one in five visitors inspired to come here after seeing Scotland on the big or small screen, VisitScotland expects visitor numbers to grow further with the release of Outlaw King.

Touring production to teach pupils about Scottish history

Pupils in Bearsden are set for a history lesson with a difference as a new Jacobite opera is set to visit schools next year.

Scottish Opera will tour the production, titled 1719!, around the country in their forthcoming primary schools tour, which will visit more than 50 locations, reaching thousands of students. The tour will commemorate 300 years since the Jacobite Risings, one of the most dramatic periods in Scottish history.

The show will take young viewers "back to a key moment in Scottish history to tell the story of the Jacobite Scots locked in a desperate struggle to restore the House of Stuart to the throne of Great Britain, while the Hanoverian King George I argued with other European rulers over the lands and riches of the New World".

Beginning in Bearsden in January, it will cover 300-year-old ground, focusing on the assembly of Jacobites and their Spanish allies in Glen Shiel.

The battle with the forces of King George marked

the last close engagement of British and European troops on UK soil, ending in defeat for the Stuart supporters. Children in primaries five, six and seven will learn the songs in their classrooms before working with the national company to put on a show for their parents and schoolmates.

Jane Davidson, director of outreach and education at Scottish Opera, said: "An amazing way to learn about one of the most dramatic and exciting periods in Scottish history, 1719! features more battles than Braveheart and is a thrilling adventure that pits the Jacobite troops and their Spanish allies against the forces of King George's Government in the mountains surrounding Glen Shiel."

"Although not the most famous of engagement in the Jacobite wars, it had far reaching significance for Britain's role in Europe and 300 years later, is still recalled in the name Sgurr nan Spainteach – the Peak of the Spaniards – in recognition of the Spanish troops who fought there."

New facilities for childcare

Families with young children in Bearsden, Kirkintilloch and Milngavie are set to benefit from new early years facilities, which have been planned for each town.

Representing an investment of more than £4.5m, the three centres will help East Dunbartonshire Council deliver on the Scottish Government pledge to increase early learning and childcare hours for each child from 2020.

The new buildings will create spaces for 272 children, comprising 88 in Bearsden, 96 in Kirkintilloch and 88 in Milnaavie.

The development sites are the former Brookwood Library in Bearsden: land across from Kirkintilloch Police Office at Southbank Marina and the former St Joseph's Primary in Milngavie.

By 2020, all three- and four-year olds and all eligible two-year olds will be entitled to 1140 hours free early learning and childcare, an increase on the 600 hours currently provided.

Joint Leader, Councillor Andrew Polson, said: "There



is a great deal of work to be done to ensure that, come 2020, the Council is in a position to offer families the best possible choice of early learning and childcare services.

"The three new facilities will go some way towards meeting demand and it is great to see that we have been able to identify sites that formerly housed Council services for that purpose. Future generations will benefit from these community resources as their parents and grandparents have done."



Keeping the community in mind

New research by Contact the Elderly has highlighted 'Christmas anxiety' as a common issue, stressing the importance of reaching out to vulnerable people in the community.

The research was commissioned by the charity to highlight how societal pressures can have a huge impact on older people who are often left forgotten and forced to spend Christmas alone.

The survey, which was sent out to 2,000 respondents across the UK, found that almost 20 per cent of us worry about upsetting family members when making Christmas plans, even though 44 per cent of people make the



same festive plans every year.

The charity released the festive research to coincide with the news that they've joined forces with Community Christmas, an organisation which aims to ensure no older person spends Christmas Day alone unless they want to. With nearly half a million older people facing spending Christmas alone, many of whom have

been widowed, the charities are encouraging communities to come together and provide companionship for older people who have nowhere to go.

Meryl Davies, Chief Executive of Contact the Elderly, said: "We want to ensure Community Christmas continues to grow and to encourage people across the UK to think about any older people in their local communities who might not have plans for Christmas Day. This is a chance to tell older people about Community Christmas, or look at the website for them to find their nearest event."

Service halts over winter months

Residents in Bearsden and Milngavie are being reminded that their green bins won't be emptied over the winter break.

Collections of garden waste ceased in November and will continue for a period of three months before resuming in March 2019.

Councillor Billy Hendry, Convener of the Council's Place, Neighbourhood & Corporate Assets Committee, said: "During the winter months the demand for garden waste collections reduces greatly as people are less active in the garden and there is little plant growth.

"However, any residents



that do find they have some garden waste during these months can take it to our Mavis Valley Recycling Centre in Bishopbriggs. Alternatively, our green-fingered residents could try their hand at home composting.

"There will also be a oneoff collection of garden waste bins in January, which we will advertise on our website and social media nearer the time.

"After this short break, we will resume the normal collection, which is available to all East Dunbartonshire residents throughout the rest of the year."

The material collected in garden waste bins makes a large contribution to the Council's recycling rate, with 8100 tonnes of garden waste being collected from the kerbside last year.

Experts at Wyevale Garden Centres agree there are three types to go for if you're after a fragrant festive tree. Plus, there are plenty of ways to add scent to vour tree, too.

Fraser fir

Tim Evans, Wyevale's buying manager for horticulture, explains: "The tree that has the most scent is the Fraser fir, which is a bit citrussy."

It's ideal for those with limited space as it's slim, so you're less likely to brush past it and knock off decorations in a smaller room, but it also has a great shape and

It's likely to be more expensive than the more popular Nordmann. and there won't be as many available as it's a more difficult tree to grow commercially.

Nordmann fir

The most popular tree, it won't drop its needles for the duration of the festive season and will give you some scent if you look after it and keep it watered. People love it because of its dense branches. uniform shape and good variety of sizes.

Norway spruce

While some people are reluctant to buy this type of tree because it is notorious for shedding its needles, what it loses in longevity it gains in scent, emitting a pine resin fragrance.

It's a good tree if you're putting it up last minute, or at least closer

non-drop trees.

Once your tree's in place, there are other ways to add scent to the branches.

Use scented pine cones

You could either make your own or buy a pack of fragranced cones such as these by Milford Collection which feature a blend of cinnamon, citrus and festive spices (£8.48, Amazon).


Go natural with spice and dried citrus.

Secure cinnamon sticks and dried oranges with florists' wire to create a natural decoration for the tree and add some scent.

Buy scent-infused decorations.

There are a few of these on the market, but among the best and most stylish are a set of eight bells from The White Company (£20), infused with notes of cinnamon, clove and fresh orange.
