Gin distillery samples the benefits of new Superfast Broadband programme

A Milngavie distillery is now one of the best-connected places in Scotland, opening up a wealth of online opportunities to the family firm.

Thanks £463 to million Digital Scotland Superfast Broadband (DSSB) the family-run programme. Bardowie Gin distillerv now benefits from gigabit-capable broadband using FTTP (Fibreto-the-Premises full-fibre) technology.

Cabinet Secretary for Transport, Infrastructure and Connectivity, Michael Matheson said: "It's fantastic to see a rural business benefitting from having had FTTP deployed thanks to the Digital Scotland Superfast Broadband programme, particularly in such a beautiful location."

Bardowie Gin is distilled on the shores of Bardowie Loch near Milngavie, supplying a range of high-end restaurants and shops. Its products are also available to buy online.

Distillery owner Mark Hazell said: "Before I upgraded to FTTP, my broadband speed at the property was below 1Mbps. Most things were impossible.



"Naturally, distilling is one of the most important parts of my job, but another essential part of my business is filling in the necessary warrants so that I can sell the produce. This is done on HMRC's website and without the forms being filled in and returned, I can't sell the gin!

"Before having FTTP installed, downloading a form would take forever and the web page would actually time out on the website – eventually I'd have to start again. Now, thanks to having FTTP, these things take only a few minutes."

Robert Thorburn, Openreach partnership director for Scotland, said: "Scotland is on a journey to full-fibre technology.

"Eventually, it will replace the copper network which has kept us connected for the last century. In these final stages of the DSSB programme, our engineers are focused on building full-fibre networks for harder-to-reach communities."

A welcome addition to a local green space

One of Milngavie's environmental hidden gems is now even more welcoming to visitors, thanks to a recent upgrade.

Barloch Moor, a small but important Local Nature Conservation Site in Milnaavie, is home to a variety of wildlife and plants such as Roe Deer and Kingfisher.

Now, as part of improvement works carried out by East Dunbartonshire Council, it has two new entrance feature walls which provide a welcoming and attractive face to visitors.

Located alongside Mugdock Road, the entrance features were implemented as part of the Barloch Moor Management Plan.

Councillor Susan Murray, Vice Convener of the Place. Neighbourhood and Corporate Assets committee, said: "These



entrance features are a great improvement and are an attractive addition for what is one of Fast Dunbartonshire's lesser known environmental treasures.

"Barloch Moor is very popular with the local community and is bursting with biodiversity. I'd encourage everyone to come along to see the new entrance features and discover all that this fantastic natural space has to offer."

Barloch Moor is a wooded area with some open grassy space which covers 9.24 acres. The area boasts a rich diversity of flora and fauna and is a well-used resource for environmental education.

In 2018 two new bridges and some of the main paths within the moor were upgraded as part of the plan.



Milngavie singer-songwriter Kerri Watt is embracing a new era of her music, thanks to a Grammynominated metal producer.

At 16, she left her family home in Milngavie to study at South Orange County School of Arts in Dana Point, California and since that life-changing experience, she has immersed herself in the world of music.

One person who appears to believe in Kerri is country legend, and American Idol Urban, judge Keith acquired her singing services last year in London.

Kerri will also be working hard this year to promote her forthcoming album.

She has just released her single, Kissing Fools, which has a personal, 90s teen movie-inspired music video that features School of Rock star Cody Molko.

She is hoping that the song will go down well with her fans.

Kerri said: "I wanted to write a song about all my favourite movies, those kinds of movies with kiss moments that I loved growing up."

The application, for four-bedroomed detached houses, concerns a site south of Castlehill Cottage on Duntocher Road and is from Fairbright Homes Limited.

In a statement provided by the applicant's agent Jigsaw Planning, it is explained that this is a resubmission

of a previous application which was dismissed due to a lack information concerning overshadowing.

The statement adds that the land has been allocated as a housing site and the development would not negatively affect residential amenity.

Councillors make a decision on the application in due course.


Break up the day with calming yoga sessions

Reconnect with nature

Top gardening influencer Ellen Mary reveals how families can reconnect with nature in their own garden.

1. Garden tracing

Activity: Take a walk in your garden with some paper and a crayon. Trace the bark of a tree, if you have one, and a fallen leaf to stick on the paper by your tracing. Look



closely at the tree, identify it, touch the bark and the leaves. Back inside, put it on your fridge. Each time you look at your tracing, remember how you felt in the garden,

the smells and the air on your face.

2. Walk barefoot

Activity: Get your socks off! Put your shoes aside. Feel liberated by walking outside on the lawn or a soft outdoor surface with bare feet. Feel the natural

negative charge from the earth being absorbed through the soles of your feet. Breathe deeply and relax.

3. Spot a star constellation

Activity: Did you ever stare at the stars as a child and wonder what they are? Glistening in the sky, light years away. It's really good fun identifying star constellations but if you can't work out where Orion

is, make your own shapes in the sky like a dot-to-dot drawing.

4. Sow some seeds

Activity: Be mindful and sow some seeds. Before you do, feel the seeds in your hand. What is the texture, shape, size? Look close at the detail - does each

seed differ?

Be marvelled at the way those tiny seeds become big fruits, vegetables or flowers.

5. See life beneath

Activity: Revisit those memorable moments with your children, lifting a stone in your garden and encouraging the children to stay inquisitive and keep looking.
