Could you play a part in redesigning popular gallery?

BUDDING snappers are being urged to help capture a brand new look for one of Glasgow's most loved museums.

Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum's popular Life Gallery is being redesigned show off a myriad of intriguing new specimens from the Natural History collections.

The first phase of the work was well received when unveiled in April, however, the final stage of the development will see the gallery close to the public from 5pm on Sunday, October 9 until late 2016.

No other galleries within Kelvingrove Museum will be closed.

And amateur photographers are being asked to share any spectacular shots they have for use in the redevelopment of the gallery and the corresponding website.

Photographs can be uploaded to a dedicated Flickr account for potential use as backdrops or as part of text story panels. All photos will be fully credited.

The creation of the new gallery is a two-year project. Work is now underway on a number of stories that relate to animals native to Australasia, the Arctic and South America, together with a thought-provoking exhibit on conservation issues. On completion of this final phase of work people visiting Kelvingrove Museum will be able to travel on a 'Pole to Pole' adventure as they



wander through the redisplayed Life Gallery.

New family-focused displays will allow visitors to journey through the story of flightless birds from Australasia; the incredible pilgrimage of leatherback turtles across the Pacific, the stunning scenery of the Arctic and how wildlife cleverly camouflages itself in that barren wilderness, together with exhibits on El Dorado, the Andes and the important issue of safeguarding our natural habitats to ensure all of this is protected for the future.

Amongst the exciting new specimens Glasgow Museums hope to feature are a numbat, a cassowary, green and hawksbill turtles, a muskox, polar bear, ibex and others, which had been in the museum's stores and have been specially prepared for display.

Dramatic wildlife and landscape images will help convey the intricacies of animal life across the world. Kelvingrove Museum is asking amateur photographers to share any spectacular shots they have for use in the redevelopment of the Life Gallery and the corresponding website. Prospective photographs can be uploaded to a dedicated Flickr account www.flickr.com/groups/ lifeatkelvingrove/.

Natural Sciences Research Manager, Richard Sutcliffe, said: "We are particularly keen on images of snow scenes and arctic animals such as the polar bear, arctic fox and snowy owls to bring our Arctic Circle section to life. Or, if you've ever been to Australia, we'd love to see vour pictures of the rain forest, coral at the Great Barrier Reef and wildlife images of animals from down under like the platypus, kangaroo and emu. Closer to home, if you've been lucky enough to snap the terrapin in Kelvingrove Park pond we'd love to see it!"

Kelvinside Academy welcomes new headteacher

IT was back to school time for Ian Munro as he was appointed headteacher at Kelvinside Academy earlier this summer.

At 34, Mr Munro is the youngest headteacher in the UK's independent school sector.

Ahead of his new role he praised the school for its 'positive spirit' and 'sense of community' and hailed the academy's commitment to offering both a broad and challenging education to youngsters as a 'character that is as important as grades.' A graduate of Edinburgh University, Mr Munro is no stranger to private schooling as he attended both state and private establishments before making his way on to further education.


While notable CV highlights include working as head of extra-curricular activities at George Heriot's School in Edinburgh, head of biology at Gordonstoun and deputy head of Shiplake College, in Henley on Thames.

He takes over the position from Allan Gilliland who took on the role for a year after former headteacher Robert Karling died suddenly in 2015.

Chairman of the school's governors Donald Wilson welcomed Mr Munro to the school saying that he 'demonstrated understanding of Kelvinside's vibrant and distinctive ethos' and welcomed his 'dynamic' outlook.

The school became fully independent in 1985 and coeducational in 1998.






