

Fans will have the chance to speak with the Scots novelist, whose books mix comedy, politics,



# Blood donation drive is a chance to save a life

NEWTON Mearns residents are being urged to help save a life this year by giving blood.

The Scottish Blood Transfusion Service (SNBTS) is calling on locals to join them at a donation session this spring to help make a difference across the country.

The process of giving blood is quick and simple.

After filling in a donor health check questionnaire and having a check-up from a nurse, a donors hemoglobin (iron) level will be tested to ensure they can actually spare a pint of blood.

Once everything is checked and in order, they will then make their donation

Each donation takes around 10 to 15 minutes and staff aim to take around 470mls of blood - with additional samples for testing.

This may sound like a lot but is actually less than a pint in total.

Donors will have a team member with them at all times to ensure they are comfortable and happy with the process.

Every day Scottish patients receive life-enhancing or life-saving treatments using the blood donated.

Within 24 hours of a donation, blood is processed, tested and available for use and one blood donation can save or improve the lives of up to three people

However, figures reveal that only five per cent of the population currently give blood.

Residents will have the chance to pay it forward on May 4 at Church of Broom on Broom Road East.

The SNBTS team will set up shop between 2pm and 3.45m then again from 5.15pm until 7.30pm

## Keep an eye out for council tax scam

NEWTON Mearns residents are being urged to look out for a scam which claims to give people a refund on their council tax.

The warning comes after the council's Trading Standards team received a number of reports from locals who have received an email claiming they have been issued a refund.

Residents are being reminded never to give out any bank details by email or over the phone following an unsolicited request.

The email, which appears to be sent by 'Miss Rourke' from Unity Partnership, claims that the receiver is due a Council Tax refund and by clicking on a link and confirming personal details, the money will be credited to your bank account.

Research has found that eight per cent of people will fall victim to at least one scam in their lifetime. In extreme cases, people can lose hundreds of thousands of pounds to scams. This costs the UK economy £3.5 billion each year.

An anonymous local resident added: "I was wary when I received this email and picked up the phone to Trading Standards for advice before doing anything.



"I was called back within the hour and advised that this was a scam and to delete straight away. It's a shame because a lot of people will fall for this."



## Campaign cleans up at national awards

A CAMPAIGN to clean up the boating pond at Rouken Glen Park has scooped a national award.

The council took home the Successful Campaign Award at the Local Environmental Quality Awards hosted by environmental charity, Keep Scotland Beautiful.

Celebrating the success from across the Keep Scotland Beautiful Local Environmental Quality Network, the awards recognise work in improving the cleanliness and quality of the environment.

The council's winning 'Clean Pond Healthy Ducks' initiative was a three year project to restore the popular pond.

As part of the campaign, Park Activities Rangers visited local schools to educate pupils about pond health, duck feeding and the implications of littering.

This, alongside new signage, clean ups and weed clearing, resulted in the pond being restored to a healthy, thriving home for wildlife.

## New driving laws in force

NEWTON Mearns drivers caught using a phone behind the wheel will face harsher penalties.

The news comes as March 1 saw the number of penalty points for holding and using a mobile phone when driving increase from three to six points.

Drivers also face an increased fine of £200.

Speaking of the new law Chief Superintendent Andy Edmonston, Head of Road Policing for Police Scotland, said: "The risks associated with using a phone while behind the wheel have always been very clear.

"Any driver will be distracted by a phone call or text message as it affects the ability to concentrate and anticipate the road ahead, putting the driver and other road users at risk.

"Distraction reduces hazard perception and increases reaction times in a similar way to drink-driving, making drivers much more likely to cause deaths and injuries. Drivers who think they can multi-task are fooling themselves: research shows

98 per cent are unable to divide their time without it affecting performance.

"Talking on a phone hand-held or hands free, texting, emailing, adjusting sat navs, eating, drinking and smoking are all proven to increase crash risk.

"The law says a driver must at all times be in proper control of their vehicle. If at any time they are not they may be guilty of an offence.

"Police Scotland consistently targets these offences on a daily basis to reduce road casualties and will deal with offences detected in an appropriate manner.

"We are using this change in the law to, once again, reminding drivers that using a mobile phone while driving has always been unacceptable and even careful drivers can be distracted by a call or text – and a split-second lapse in concentration could result in a serious or fatal collision."



## First Responders are on call to offer dedicated support

#### COULD you help save a life?

That's the question being asked of local residents as the Newton Mearns Community First Responders searches for new recruits.

The group is looking for people to attend 999 emergency calls as a First Responder in conjunction with the Scottish Ambulance Service.

Community First Responders will be based in Newton Mearns but offer support to surrounding including Clarkston, Giffnock areas Thornliebank.

Those interested in taking part will undertake a weekend of training lasting eight hours each day offering a chance to learn more about basic life support, incident management, basic first aid and use of defibrillation equipment.

Following training, first responders will team up with a buddy for four weeks before having the

option to go solo or continue working within a pair.

Participants will be required to volunteer 12 hours per month to ensure emergency medical help is available in a timely fashion when a 999 call is placed in the local area.

Due to the nature of the work all volunteers are required to have access to transport at all times whilst on call and if a volunteer is a non-driver they must have access to transport immediately available for duration of the shift - i.e a friend must be on call with them.

All participants must be over the age of 18 and Enhanced Disclosure Check and references will be required.
