The play, produced by Cathkin Park Ltd, is visiting Giffnock as part of a Scottish tour.



A spokesperson said: "It doesn't matter if you're not a boxing fan – this show is about the extraordinary life of a Scottish icon.

"It is the ultimate rags-to-riches-to-rags story."

The show starts at 7.30pm and an age recommendation of 14 and over is in place, as there is some strong language.

Standard tickets cost £20, with concessions available for £18. Students can gain entry for £15.


















Investing in a brighter future



Teachers trained on mental health

A new mental health learning resource for school teachers has been rolled out across Scotland by the charity SAMH (Scottish Association for Mental Health).

'We All Have Mental Health' is a free e-learning tool aimed at teachers, equipping them with the skills and knowledge to recognise and respond to pupils who are experiencing mental health problems.

In 2017 SAMH surveyed over 3,000 school staff and found that two-thirds of teachers didn't feel they had received sufficient training in mental health to allow them to carry out their role. The mental health charity has created "We All Have Mental Health" in direct response to that feedback using charitable funds.


In response to growing concerns about children and young people's mental health highlighted by organisations including SAMH, the Scottish Government has recently committed to ensuring all secondary schools across Scotland have a counsellor from 2020 onwards. SAMH wants to see

a whole-school approach, in which all school staff can support students through mental health challenges.

'We All Have Mental Health' has been designed to introduce mental health to teachers. The resource has been created by SAMH in conjunction with the General Teaching Council for Scotland.

Pam Steel, education development officer at SAMH, said: "Everyone with a role in a young person's comes to mental health, the golden rule for teachers is 'recognise, respond, and refer'. Through our new online tool, teachers now have access to a resource which can help them recognise, respond to and, if necessary, refer pupils who are experiencing mental health problems.





Expansion plans for nursery

Crookfur Primary Nursery Class in Newton Mearns is to relocate to a new, purpose-built facility.

From August 2020 the class will move to the new Crookfur Family Centre, which is being built to replace the current Crookfur Pavilion. Building work is set to start on the project in the coming months.

The new family centre will continue to be managed by Crookfur Primary head teacher, Sheena McGuigan, and will

offer more places than available at present, as well as opening all year round, rather than just term time.

Relocating the nursery class to the pavilion site will also mean that the former nursery class accommodation can be used by the primary school from August 2020.

The move is part of the council's early years expansion plan, which is being put in place as a result of changes being introduced by the Scottish Government.

Local authorities currently provide 600 free hours of childcare for all three and four-year-olds and eligible two-year-olds, and this will increase to 1,140 hours by August 2020. This is a rise to 30 hours per week, matching the amount of time children spend each week in primary school.

Director of Education Mhairi Shaw said: "The aim of our expansion plan is to

offer families more opportunities for flexibility and choice for their early learning and childcare needs. Creating these new facilities will help us to achieve this, whilst also providing more space in our schools which will benefit our pupils."

MP backs new Cancer Research campaign

A new Cancer Research campaign urging the Scottish Government to address a shortfall in the cancer diagnosis workforce has been backed by East Renfrewshire's MP.

Paul Masterton gave his backing to the initiative after discovering survival rates can be as much as three times higher if cancer is caught early.

More than 18,000 people waited longer than six weeks to have a cancer diagnosis last year.

Mr Masterton said he was delighted to meet the Cancer Research team to help their cause in getting patients diagnosed sooner.

He said: "Like everywhere in Scotland, cancer has a huge effect on families in East Renfrewshire, so it was interesting to meet with Cancer Research UK team to hear more about their priorities for diagnosing patients sooner in Scotland."

National guidelines suggest that no-one should be waiting longer than six weeks for a cancer diagnosis.

However, statistics revealed more than 20 per cent of people wait longer than six weeks for diagnosis.

Gordon Matheson, public affairs manager in Scotland at Cancer Research UK, said: "The NHS is under continued strain, with too many patients still waiting too long for tests, some of which could detect cancer. "With a welcome focus on screening and early detection of cancer, there's

an urgent need to comprehensively address workforce shortages."

Go vertical

Discover simple solutions to cut down

on your food waste

The UK currently wastes 10.2 million tonnes of food a year - it's a shocking stat, and we're all a little bit responsible.

According to the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, 1.8 million tonnes of that waste comes from food manufacture, one million from the hospitality sector, 260,000 from retail, and the rest from households - but hopefully things are changing.

Want to take on the challenge, and cut your contributions towards climate change too? Here are some steps to take at home, to reduce your household's food waste...

1. Buy what you need

If a recipe you're planning on making only requires one red pepper, avoid buying the multipack - even if it works out cheaper - if you know you're unlikely to eat the rest.

2. Save all your leftover pasta

Chuck odds and ends of spaghetti and fusilli in together, for a medley that can be thrown in with a sauce, or into soup.

3. Grate cheese and freeze

Preempt mouldy ends of cheese by grating the lot and freezing for a later date, when mac and cheese, lasagne or cheese on toast is needed.

4. Pickle and preserve

Got a glut of tomatoes, cucumber, cabbage etc.? Pickling veggies, or making chutneys, is a great way to use them up, and store them for later use.

5. Eat the skins

Opt for skin-on chips, roast carrots and parsnips with the skins on, and even beetroot skin is more than edible - it'll save you time not having to peel 'em too.





6. Keep an eye on use by dates

Whether in the fridge, or if you're bulk shopping, freeze things immediately if you know you're not going to get round to eating them in time to beat their use by date.

7. Use your nose

The best before date is a guideline, use your nose - if something smells OK and looks OK to eat, it probably is. Use by dates though ought to be abided by.

8. Buy the ugly fruit and veg

The wonky veg is most often the kind that ends up in landfill - rescue it, it'll taste just as good as the aesthetically beautiful stuff.

9. Plan meals ahead, and think about how you could reuse leftovers

If you have a meal plan for the week, it'll cut down on your fridge filling with random bits of food without a job to do. Also, if you know what you've got in, you'll be able to work out what to do with leftovers too.

10. Keep your fridge tidy

If you can see what you've got, use by dates will be easier to access, and you'll avoid ending up with a salad drawer of green, decaying mush.


11. Make soups, stocks and smoothies
