



Small businesses thriving in Glasgow hotspots

The West End has played a huge contributing factor to the recent news that Glasgow is the number one city in the UK for independent businesses, new research has revealed.

The city has come out on top in a study to determine which areas are most supportive towards small local companies.

It ranked first for the highest number of independent pubs and newsagents and second in the food and restaurants categories.

The news has been welcomed by the Federation of Small Businesses (FSB) in Scotland, which urged the people of Glasgow to continuing backing independent firms. the

Hisashi Kuboyama, organisation's development manager for Glasgow. said: "Anvone that knows Glasgow would recognise this research showing that our city is a small business hotspot.

"From the city centre, to the up and coming Southside, to the leafy West End - in all of these areas we see fantastic local operators delivering brilliant products and service while injecting character and culture into our neighbourhoods."

The research, conducted by business finance provider Liberis, looked at the number of local businesses per capita in 20 major cities.

It analysed the number of independent stores per city combined with a penalty score for the number of big chains.

Mr Kubovama said: "If we want Glasgow's smaller firms to thrive. people need to support them.

"This needn't be a chore and might mean going for a pint in the local pub or buying something nice for tea in the local deli, butcher or fishmonger, or even seeking out the independent book or music shop.

"Further. political decisionmakers need to do everything in their power to help smaller firms' thrive - like ensuring their needs are considered when transport changes are proposed or doing what they can to keep down business overheads."

Poppy's sugar-free products are the icing on the cake

Poppy Muricane was laughed at in school when she admitted to the career advisor that her goal was to establish her own coffee shop.

At 16 she walked out of her private school with a few, average grade highers, in stark contrast to her high achieving siblings, who had all gone to university.

Fast forward 13 years and the 29-year-old now owns a thriving business and cafe in the West End selling 'sugar free' raw cakes and has catered for celebrity vegan Stella McCartney – all in the space of two years and with no catering training.

She said: "It's a lot of hard

work, because I'm having to juggle making the cakes, running a wholesale cake business and running a cafe. I have to get up at 5am and work 10-hour days but I love it."

Things really took off for Poppy after she landed a slot at the Let's Eat Glasgow food festival, through a family friend, giving her the exposure of up to 10,000 potential customers.

She says: "I basically Googled how to start your own food business and that night I registered, did a little mind map and came up with the name.

"I had two months to prepare for the stall.

"My stall was the busiest there - I sold out and then people approached me, restaurateurs asking if they could stock my cakes."

Poppy now makes cakes for Piece in Finnieston, Grassroots Cafe and Rose & Grants, Purple Cat Cafe and other cafes in Dalkeith and Oban. A far cry from when she started out in her mum's kitchen.

She was asked to supply a vegan cake for a photo shoot by fashion designer Stella McCartney and has also been approached by Cancer charities to supply cakes for patients who are restricting refined sugar from their diet.

Have your say on Govan/ Partick link

Feedback is being sought from residents in Govan and Partick for their views on plans that could transform the two city districts.

Glasgow City Council's Strategic Development Framework (SDF) provides an update on the development of a bridge that would connect Partick and Govan as well as develop Govan as a residential area.

If plans are approved it is hoped the work will improve access to wider economic, social and cultural opportunities north and south of the river.

The SDF aims to introduce the Govan and Partick area as a vibrant, world class city with a thriving, inclusive, economy where everyone can flourish and benefit from the city's success.



A plan will be put in place to ensure museums, parks, entertainment venues and third sector organisations can develop as a world class "culture cluster" encouraging tourism and visitors.

The Govan-Partick bridge could link the Riverside Museum, Govan Old Church and Central Govan for the first time.

The local authority is also looking for feedback on plans to create 202 new homes, restaurants, cafes and shops which would take advantage of the proposed bridge link.

Dino-mite display at Kelvingrove

An iconic 111-year-old dinosaur has arrived in Glasgow.

Dippy, the famous diplodocus who usually resides within the Natural History Museum's central entrance hall, is currently on a UK tour and arrived at Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum on Tuesday, 22 January where he will remain until Monday, 6 May.

As the only Scottish stop of the tour, Dippy's temporary home in the West End will give visitors the chance to get up close to this impressive dinosaur cast.

Dippy on Tour is on a mission to inspire five million natural history adventures and encourage families to explore nature on their doorstep.

Glasgow Museums will use Dippy's visit to showcase the



city's natural history collection and stunning local natural habitats. Chair of Glasgow Life, Councillor David McDonald, said: "We are absolutely thrilled that Dippy will be visiting Kelvingrove Museum as part of the Natural History Museum's 'Dippy on Tour'.








Book Review

While none of these books are a quick-fix to all of life's problems, they can suggest helpful hints, cognitive strategies and straight-talking advice for living more optimistically...




The Art Of Happiness: A Handbook For Living




Happiness By Design: Change What You Do, Not How You Think
